

### MAINE SPRING CONCERT

# 2022-2023 Registration for 4K Learning Academies and Community Sites

**Begins February 1, 2022** 

Registration for the free, half-day 4K Program is a two-step process for all eligible children (Four years of age on or before September 1, 2022)

### Visit the 4K & Early Childhood page at www.wausauschools.org

Complete and submit the online form. You will receive an electronic confirmation following the completion of Step 1. The online registration indicates your interest in 4K and preferred site of attendance; however, the registration form must be verified (Step 2) before your child is fully registered and assigned to a site.
